### Dr. Chun Key LAW

Dr. Law graduated from the University of Hong Kong in 1981. He then worked under Professor John H.C. Ho and Dr. Y.F. Poon at the Institute of Radiotherapy & Oncology (now called Department of Clinical Oncology), Queen Elizabeth Hospital. He had post-Fellowship training in various centres of excellence in UK in 1988. In 1994, Dr. Law was granted the H.C. Ho Foundation Scholarship to receive training in Stereotactic Radiotherapy in Royal Marsden Hospital, London; and Conformal RT, Arc therapy and CT simulator in Kyoto University. In 1995, Dr. Law furthered his experience in the Joint Center for Radiation Therapy, Boston, U.S.A. He became Consultant in 1995 and Chief of Service in 2003 until retirement in 2012. Upon his retirement, Dr. Law joined Hong Kong Adventist Hospital as Clinical Director to lead the newly formed Oncology Center in 2012.

Dr. Law holds a number of important academic and professional positions. He is the President of the Hong Kong College of Radiologists (HKCR) since 2008. He is a past President of the Hong Kong Head and Neck Society and ex-Vice Presidents of the Hong Kong Nasopharyngeal Carcinoma Study Group and the Hong Kong Lung Cancer Study Group. He is also an Honorary Clinical Associate Professor in the Department of Clinical Oncology, The University of Hong Kong, and an Honorary Consultant in the Radiation Therapy Center of Kiang Wu Hospital, Macau. As a former Executive Council Member of the Hong Kong Anti-Cancer Society and current advisors in many patient-help groups, Dr. Law is active in local patient cancer educational activities.

Dr. Law has actively engaged in cancer research. He has authored or co-authored over 70 peer review articles, covering cancer epidemiology, nasopharyngeal carcinoma, thyroid cancer and lung cancer. He was the Director of Hong Kong Cancer Registry of the Hospital Authority from 2004 to 2012 and had instituted a number of important improvement programmes during his office.

Dr. Law is also active in public services in Hong Kong. He has been a member of the Cancer Coordinating Committee of the Food and Health Bureau from 2005 to 2014, and is currently a member of the Cancer Expert Working Group of the Centre for Health Protection, the Working Group on Defining High-Risk Medical Procedures/ Practices performed in an Ambulatory Setting; Convenor of the Expert Group on Chemotherapy, Diagnostic/ Interventional Radiological Procedures, and the Colorectal Cancer Screening Pilot Programme Task Force, Department of Health.

During his service in HA and his Presidency of the HKCR, Dr. Law has made significant contributions to the professional development of the medical physicists in enhancing their clinical roles and responsibilities as well as their manpower development. He has helped established and maintained a strong partnership between the Hong Kong College of Radiologists and the medical physicist community on such issues as educational, scientific and professional activities.

In recognition of his outstanding achievements and significant contributions in the specialty of radiology and in promoting the development of the medical physics profession in Hong Kong, the Council of HKIPM proudly presents Dr. Chun-Key Law for the conferment of the Honorary Fellowship of the Institution.
