Dr. Lilian Leong is an internationally renowned radiologist who has made outstanding contributions and achievements in promoting and developing Radiology Education & Services for the betterment of healthcare delivery to the community of Hong Kong and for the region. She has helped establishing Hong Kong radiology in the Regional and International arena. She is a leading specialist in radiology and has for many years been leading the strategic planning of radiology services and the state-of-the-art imaging technologies in public hospitals in the territory.

Dr. Leong is the Founding President of the Hong Kong College of Radiologists. She played a pivotal role in establishing and running a world class specialists training system for the medical specialty of radiology in Hong Kong. The people of Hong Kong has benefited from her success in producing radiologists of the highest professional standard.

Dr. Leong is widely recognized by numerous national and international professional appointments and awards. She was elected the President of Asian-Oceanian Society of Radiology (2001-2004), and International Adviser for Radiology Education of the Harvard Medical School. She holds prestigious honorary membership appointments with professional radiology societies in China, Europe, and United States of America. She also holds the Honorary Doctorate of Science of the University of Aberdeen, UK. In recognition of her extraordinary contribution to radiology internationally and in particular to her dedication and commitment towards achieving close collaboration between Hong Kong and other international radiological organizations, Dr. Leong was awarded the Beclere Medal by the International Society of Radiology in 2006; the Gold Medal by The Royal College of Radiologists of United Kingdom in 2006; the Gold Medal of the Asian Oceanian Society of Radiology in 2008 and Honorary Fellow by the American College of Radiology in 2009. She was made Justice of Peace in 2001 and was conferred Bronze Bauhinia Star by the HKSAR Government in 2008.

Dr. Leong's contributions extend beyond radiology and into many other areas, including medical physics. She has played a key role in the development of the medical physics profession in Hong Kong. Like all great leaders in radiation medicine, she recognizes the important role of the medical physicists in radiology and the need for a high standard of practice of the medical physicists. Dr. Leong has, particularly during her Presidency of the Hong Kong College of Radiologists, established a strong partnership between the College and the medical physicist community on such issues as education and training and scientific activities. These collaborative engagements helped raising the profile and professional status of the medical physicists in the medical community.

In recognition of her celebrated achievements and lifelong contributions to radiology services, the medical profession and the medical physics profession, the Council of HKIPM proudly presents Dr. Lilian Leong for the conferment of the Honorary Fellowship of the Institution.
